'Footsteps in the Attic' is finally here!



After a delay of more than two years, Paul F. Eno's much anticipated book *Footsteps in the Attic: More First-Hand Accounts of the*

Paranormal in New England will finally be released in September 2002!

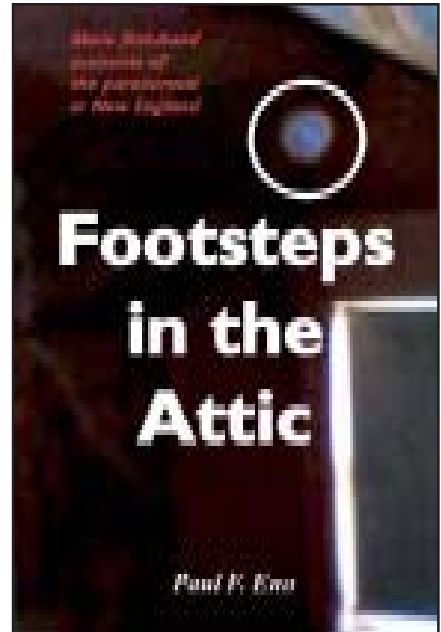
At 170 pages and 20 photos, the book is 75 percent larger than Paul's acclaimed 1998 book *Faces at the Window*. It contains 16 of his most hair-raising cases as a 30-year ghost hunter and journalist. But in his breezy style, Paul uses these experiences to paint a unique and panoramic vision of life and the universe that will bring a tear to the eye and hope to the heart.

Paul recounts cases that span the years 1978-2002, including the

mind-blowing "Haunter" incident in York, Maine; the "Phantom House" of Vermont; the "Baddest Poltergeist in New England" of New Haven; Connecticut, and the non-stop "Drawn by Murder" affair in Rhode Island. But there also are heart-warming cases, such as the deeply moving "Crying Ghost" of Auburn, Massachusetts, and "The White Sword" of Portland, Maine.

"*Footsteps* was delayed for so long because I kept adding to it! I hope the book is better because of it," Paul states.

Paul to appear on the Travel Channel

Author and paranormal investigator Paul F. Eno will appear on the Travel Channel's *Secrets of Haunted New England*, tentatively set for broadcast in January 2003.

The show was taped all over New England this past summer, and Paul's segments were taped in Newport, R.I., August 1 and 2, mostly at the Common Burial Ground.

"I'm supposed to be the expert who interprets the cases they talk about in the show, but my theories of the paranormal aren't the usual popular baloney," Paul says.

"The director kept making faces at me while I was on camera, so heaven knows how it's going to come out!"
